David and Eric Martin took over the family estate in 2005, exactly a century after their great-grandfather had founded it. They produce a series of haute-couture wines originating from exceptional terroirs and generally matured in oak tuns for 12 to 36 months, a tradition that they defend with great vigour. Their unfiltered reds are always smooth and satisfying and can be aged for about ten years.
